



PACIFIC NATURE CROCODILES + BIJAGUAL WATERFALL

Discover first-hand the wonders of nature in the Rain Forest. This adventure takes place on the Pacific Coast of Costa Rica, first along the Tárcoles River and then at Bijagual town. The **Crocodile Safari** explores an area surrounded by mangroves and located in a transitional forest, where literally hundreds of different kinds of mammals, birds and reptiles flourish. This is a nesting site for the Scarlet Macaw and large colonies of crocodiles – some measuring up to 23 feet in length. After this adventure, we will continue to Bijagual to enjoy a horseback riding that ends at a wonderful waterfall. Plummeting from cliffs deep in the jungle, the **Bijagual Waterfalls** await to be discovered by explorers willing to take the challenge and extract its secrets. Climbing the small range between Carara National Park and the protected zone of Turrubares, the road to Bijagual is a rewarding experience, filled with stunning views of the Pacific Ocean and the coastal fishing villages, alternating with dramatic changes in vegetation. Early risers assisted by expert naturalist guides will observe wildlife, easily spotted in the many canyons traversed by the winding road. After this scenic drive, visitors continue on horseback facilitating access to this magical place. Explorers will revel in the pleasures of nature with a plunge into the pristine pools at the base of the waterfalls, and finish with a Costa Rican traditional lunch. A must for all participants!

What to bring: Cool comfortable clothes and shoes, sun block, swim suite, insect repellent, hat, binoculars & camera. **Length of tour:** Full day.
